Background

The SAFEGROUNDS Land Management and Site Characterisation guidance documents are currently being updated to take account of technical, regulatory and organisational developments and to benefit from experience of their use. At the same time a new complementary Guide to the Comparison of Land Management Options is being prepared. Consultation on the first drafts of these documents will take place during September and October 2007.

This workshop is an integral part of the consultation on these documents. It will provide an opportunity for contractors and consultants, who will be asked to implement the guidance, to discuss the key issues addressed by the documents and to feed in their views.

The event will also provide an opportunity for practitioners working on land management and decommissioning projects to improve their knowledge of the good practice approaches developed by SAFEGROUNDS with the support of the NDA, MoD, site operators, Regulators and NGOs.

One hoped-for outcome from this SAFESPUR meeting is to identify a small group of members to take the collective views of the meeting forward to a SAFEGROUNDS multi-stakeholder workshop in early November 2007.
